13. After consultation with the Stated Clerk, the Moderator declared a **QUORUM** (G-3.0300 – 12 TE and 12 RE).

Elaine Swanson, Clerk of Session for Community Church, Wells, Nevada brought greetings from the congregation and enthusiastically thanked the Presbytery for their grant of \$15,000 to replace windows and exterior siding. The congregation has \$30,000 to put with this grant to complete the restoration. Previously, the church used \$27,000 of its own monies to make repairs to the church after the 2008 earthquake damage, \$24,500 to reroof the sanctuary in 2017.

Joan Jeffers, Stated Clerk, read a letter from Rev. Lee Styer, Henderson Presbyterian Church, thanking the Presbytery for their assistance in reimbursing the insurance deductible payment of \$1,000, in the face of Henderson Presbyterian Church's recent burglaries. Rev. Styer also provided a health update with request for prayers.

- 1. MISSION OUTREACH, reported by Rev. Jim Houston-Hencken, Chair:
 - A. The Chair discussed the need for a clarification to the charge and scope of the committee. The Chair moved the following language:
 - "Under the authority of the Presbytery of Nevada the Mission Outreach Committee exists to further the mission of Jesus Christ within Churches and ministries of the Presbytery of Nevada by overseeing and coordinating all mission projects and programs of the presbytery. This includes financial support for mission projects originating within our presbytery and funding for other mission programs and projects approved by the Presbytery. In addition, at the direction of the Presbytery of Nevada, the Mission Outreach Committee oversees the New Church Development programs within our Presbytery."
 - Presbytery **VOTED** to **APPROVE** the recommendation from the committee.
 - B. The Chair discussed the process Taiwanese-American Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas (TAPCLV) NCD has gone through and shared they had met all of the criteria for chartering. He moved that the church be chartered on November 25th, 2018 at 1 pm at Grace Presbyterian Church in Las Vegas, NV
 - Presbytery **VOTED** to **APPROVE** Taiwanese-American Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas (TAPCLV) NCD be chartered as a church of the PCUSA. The Rev. Paul Chen and members of the church were invited forward for prayer, the laying on of hands, and singing the Doxology. Rev. Jim Houston-Hencken prayed.
 - C. The Chair moved for approval of a chartering commission for TAPCLV. This commission will organize a chartering service and special Presbytery meeting to be held on November 25, 2018 at 1:00 pm. Chartering Committee members shall be: Endry Chow, Louisa Kuo, Scott Pan,

Presbytery **VOTED** to **APPROVE** the recommendation from the committee.

- D. Amazing Grace Elder Commissioner, Jim Stuhmer, Grace Presbyterian Church, presented a report and slide show on the continued growth of Amazing Grace Ministries in Las Vegas.
 With a budget of only \$32,000, Amazing Grace serves 20,800 ministry encounters per year.
 The program has expanded this year to include bible clubs at 4 middle schools and an additional Sunday afternoon lunch and worship program for homeless at Hope Chapel.
- E. **F.I.R.M** (Fresno Interdenominational Refugee Ministry Rev. Zack Darrah, Executive Director, presented a report on the ministry of F.I.R.M, noting that they have added an Arabic speaking staff member to work with Arabic speaking refugees making F.I.R.M the only service provider for the Arabic speaking population. F.I.R.M is dedicating a new building on Sunday, November 2, 2018, in Fresno, California that will be named in honor of F.I.R.M founder Rev. Sharon Stanley. Presbyters were invited to attend the ceremony, if possible.
- F. **PUSA's Self-Development of People (SDOP),** a poverty program, funded through One Great Hour of Sharing offerings Rev. Jim Houston-Hencken reported that a conference and workshop will be co-hosted by Grace Presbyterian Church in Las Vegas on November 9-10, 2018. He is working with the Self Development of People program at General Assembly to create a Nevada Presbytery SDOP committee and to then apply for a grant.
- G. Alaska Mission Trip Corresponding Member Rev. Jeanie Shaw, Truckee Lutheran Presbyterian Church, Truckee, CA, presented a report and video on a successful mission trip she led to Alaska. Thirty-four (34) people from Sacramento and Nevada Presbytery churches participated

- B. Art gave a brief synopsis of the May, 2018, Synod of the Pacific Assembly. **APPENDIX** C, "2018 Synod Take-Home Piece" is a summary of the May 2018 meeting. Of special note:
 - 1. (Item 4) that Synod had "Taken Steps!" to demonstrate how deeply "white privilege" affects the minority experience in America and how far from the white person's consciousness that privilege really is.
 - 2. (Item 10) Art had presented "2018 Nevada Presbytery-to-Synod Report" that introduced our Presbytery who we are, what we are, why we are and how we got to be like this. This report will be posted on our Nevada Presbytery website.
- C. Art gave us an update on Synod programs and loans; encouraging churches to take advantage of the opportunities offered by our Synod. The programs being offered are: Emerging Need Grant, Hilda V. Thompson Medical Ministry Fund and Opportunity Fund Grant. More information on each of these programs may be found on the Synod website: http://www.synodpacific.org.

4. PRESBYTERY PASTOR:

Rev. Hilda Pecoraro reported on her 3rd year in this unique position and reminded us of God's vision for our connectional church. We see in Acts 2 that the young Jerusalem church was dedicated to meeting

each other's needs, spending time together in worship, listening to the apostles' teaching and sharing in fellowship. While they were faithfully doing these things, we read in verse 47, "And day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved."

Our job is to obediently serve God and love one another in the name of Jesus, it is the Lord's job to add to our numbers. I believe that when our focus is on being the body of Christ, that church growth will be a by-product. Authentic love – fully lived out is very attractive. Jesus said, "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:35) Numeric growth is not our only goal; nor is it the only gauge of our faithfulness. Joyfully sharing the gospel of God's love and grace, hope and forgiveness through Jesus Christ is our goal. If growth follows – all the more reason for rejoicing!

And, we continue to connect through the Pastor's Luncheon, so essential to the ministers of our presbytery. It was a big success and had a great attendance. These important luncheons give pastors an opportunity to discuss pastoral issues they are unable to discuss with congregants. Special thank you's were given to Elder Elaine York, Elder Anne Sigurdson, Rev. Dr. David Pak and the wonderful ladies of the Reno Korean Kitchen.

SAFE CHURCH AND SEXUAL MISCONDUCT TRAINING by Elder Jane Odell, Transitional Executive Presbyter, Synod of the Pacific.

Jane presented a program on sexual misconduct and an overview of safe church policies. As a part of this training, Presbyters viewed a DVD entitled "Safeguarding God's People: Preventing Sexual Harassment in the Workplace." This film was followed by a great interactive discussion among Presbyters and the presenter. Child safety and protection resources for churches were recommended. Churches need to conduct their owner training and have the best policies in place. A second training will be held at the Spring Presbytery Meeting.

Rev. Pat Mecham, Chair, talked about the need for this newly reconstructed committee referencing the principles of participation and representation set forth in the Book of Order (F-1.0403). He defined the committee's structure, terms of office, and responsibilities. One of the critical responsibilities is assisting the Nominating committee to identify diverse and qualified individuals and overview of the slate. When we remember the grainy pictures on our TV's of the first people landing on the moon, we must also remember how they got there. NASA was very far-sighted in its decision to include women on its team of scientists. As seen in the film, "Hidden Figures", its decision to include women of color was also crucial to the success of the space program.

In the same way, we are wise to seek out <u>all kinds of people</u> in our various churches to serve on the committees of presbytery. WE NEED THE HELP OF EVERY PASTOR AND EVERY SESSION to identify quality people, to tell Nominating about them. This includes people who might be a little nervous about their ability to speak English, people who have never participated in presbytery before, people who have gifts that we have never considered before. PLEASE help us as we encourage as much diversity as we can muster, because the church will benefit, and God's Realm will be blessed!

10. EQUIPPING:

Rev. Al Fry, Jr., reported for Elder Delois Basnett, Chair, who is excused. The committee approved the following actions:

- A. The Hillis Fund investment monies (from partnership with Sacramento) will be sent to the Community College of Lake Tahoe for the benefit of a California college student.
- B. Meeting with the Missions committee and developing the following Equipping Committee statement of charge and scope.

"The Equipping Committee of the Presbytery of NV exists to support the ministry of Jesus Christ within the bounds of the Presbytery. We want to equip our church leaders. The scope of this committee includes training members for mission, ministry, service, and supporting ministries for youth and assisting churches to equip leaders for ministry within the body of Christ and beyond."

- C. Rev. Ray Bledsoe asked that commissioners and pastors review and provide feedback of the new First Time Elder Commissioners and First Time Pastors to Presbytery packets that this committee has prepared.
- D. Commissioner Elder Elaine Noble spoke about upcoming special offerings and encouraged our care of the earth by using reusable water bottles.

INSTALLATION OF 2018-2019 OFFICERS AND COMMITTEE CHAIRS was performed by Rev. Scott Trevithick, Holy Cross Lutheran Church, Reno, NV.

ANNOUNCEMENT - Director of Finance, Elder Vern Manke reported that <u>\$2,190</u> was received at last evening's worship service. Vern will prepare a check to mail to Henderson Presbyterian Church.

11. TRUSTEES:

Elder Ray Bledsoe, Chair reported and Director of Finance, Elder Vern Manke presented the proposed 2019 Presbytery of Nevada budget

- A. The committee Chair requested Moderator Rev. Bob Kelley to present a 2 step, 2 year per capita increase to \$46 per member in 2019 and to \$50 per member in 2020.
- B. Motion was made to amend the committee's request to approve only the first step for 2019. After discussion, a vote was called for.
- C. Presbytery VOTED to RECEIVE (it was approved) the budget, APPENDIX B, with only a 2019 increase to \$46 per member with the request that the Trustees look further into adjustments that can possibly be made to reduce/remove need for additional per capita increases in 2020.

A FAREWELL - Rev. Jim Young, Minister of Word and Sacrament, St. John's Church, Reno, NV, said a fond farewell to his Presbytery of Nevada association.

PASSING OF THE CROSS to incoming Moderator, Elder Lynne Zenier, was performed by outgoing Moderator Rev. Bob Kelley.

CLOSING REFLECTIONS, which included Toby Nelson's 911 Reflections published yesterday, were offered by Elder Bedford Holmes. Bedford offered the **closing prayer**.
