INFORMATION SHEET FALL PRESBYTERY GATHERING September 8 – 11, 2019

The Presbytery of Nevada and Zephyr Point Conference Center strive to make your stay at Zephyr Point a memorable one. Our venue is unique and beautiful but will require you to make your plans differently than in the past. We are in the mountains to be inspired, so, there is no television nor telephone in the room. Please remember internet access is sketchy. Also, you may not have access to a copy machine. If you use the one at the ZPPC main office, you will need to pay them directly.

As in years past, we will be using the <u>TALLAC Center</u>. We have only been allotted 39 rooms, the least we have ever had. We have been limited to 39 rooms; 5 have 3 queen beds, leaving 34 rooms with 2 queen beds. Once they are filled, unfortunately, you will be on your own to either negotiate a room on campus or stay off site. As always, Zephyr Point will attempt to honor any dietary restrictions you have. But these must be made <u>well in advance</u>. Please be sure to indicate such restrictions on the registration form as they will <u>NOT</u> be able to accommodate this during the gathering. We must comply with Zephyr Point's need to prepare lodging and meals in advance. We ask you to remember:

- 1. **On Sunday, REGISTRATION DOES <u>NOT</u> OPEN UNTIL 4:00 p.m.** We will be desperately trying to get ready and unable to help you.
- 2. We only have 39 rooms, so we are strongly encouraging double occupancy or triple occupancy
- 3. Any late registrations for meals, will be charged \$3.00 per meal, per person.
- 4. We can only accept checks. Payment must be made <u>prior</u> to event unless other arrangements have been made
- 5. Cars must be parked in the designated parking areas. You may bring your car down to drop off guests and luggage. You are required to complete the vehicle dash pass included with your packet and keep in your vehicle at all times.

TRANSPORTATION:

Coming from Sacramento on Hwy. 50 travel through South Lake Tahoe. Zephyr Point is 4 miles from Stateline, Nevada, on the lake side (left).

Arriving from I-80 take Hwy 267 from Truckee to Kings Beach. At Kings Beach take a Left on Hwy. 28 to Hwy. 50, then Right headed south to Zephyr Point (1/2 mile beyond Zephyr Cove Resort) (4 miles from Cave Rock Tunnel).

From Reno take Hwy. 395 toward Carson City. Go through Carson City to Hwy. 50. Turn right, follow Hwy. 50 approximately 18 miles to Zephyr Point (1/2 mile beyond Zephyr Cove Resort and 4 miles from Cave Rock Tunnel).
