Youth Mission Trip Metlakatla, Alaska August 3 to August 12, 2023



For the last 11 years, in cooperation with the Metlakatla Presbyterian Church, we have sponsored a life-changing mission trip to Metlakatla – a Tsimshian native village on the island of Annette, off the coast of southeastern Alaska. These last few years have been a transformative experience for all participants. Powerful friendships exist between our youth and the Metlakatla youth and many are still connected and communicating today!



We have been invited to return to this majestic island to partner with the Metlakatla Presbyterian Church, rekindle relationships with the Tsimshian youth, provide a Basketball Camp, Modern Dance and Drama Camp, and Robotics Camp. We will complete work projects for the community and share Christ's love through worship, support and expanding cultural awareness. In addition to partnering with the church, we will be experiencing the beauty of this ancient culture with invitations to the long house for clan dancing, canoe trips paddling a 32' foot canoe in the Alaskan Bay and learning about their exquisite carvings and totem poles.



The mission trip begins in Ketchikan, the salmon capitol of the world, with an orientation, zip-lining through the Pacific Northwest rainforest, and a chartered ferry whale watching on our way to the Island! You may watch short films on the previous mission trips at the following link:
